ONSET

Immediate

Reaction occurs within minutes after exposure

Late

Reaction occurs 8-12 hours after early phase

Delayed

Symptoms 6-48 hours after initial contact

Immediate

Symptoms within minutes to hours after initial contact

- Pruritus (itching)

- Respiratory issues
- Cardiovascular issues
